

Pharmacists starting to practice In Wales



NESA

You will need register to complete the National enhanced services accreditation (NESA) generic skills section on the WCPPE website: <https://learning.wcppe.org.uk/my/>

This will need to be completed in order to be able to provide ANY enhanced service including EHC, Smoking cessation and to access the Choose Pharmacy platform

Choose Pharmacy

In order to access the Choose pharmacy platform you need to complete the NADEX listing form

This will list the requirements you have to meet to obtain a Choose pharmacy logon and password

Medicines Use Reviews

Pharmacies in Wales can complete 400 MURs per NHS year

You will need to send a copy of your MUR certificate to Shared Services Wales in order to be able to do MURs in Wales, do this by completing the pharmacists listing form:

Discharge Medicines Reviews

Each pharmacy in Wales can complete 140 in an NHS year. If you're accredited to complete MURs then you are accredited for Discharge medicine reviews (DMRs). These are now completed on the choose pharmacy platform

DBS Checks

You will also need to complete a disclosure and barring service check to be able to access the choose pharmacy platform, details of how to do this can be found here:

Smoking cessation service

You will need to complete the NESAs generic skills and then complete the smoking cessation module. And submit the accreditation to shared services. More information on the national smoking

Emergency contraception service

You will need to complete the NESAs generic skills and then complete the EHC module. And submit the accreditation to shared services. Claiming for EHC is on the Choose pharmacy platform so a NADEX logon is essential.

Emergency supply service

This allows commissioned pharmacies to provide an emergency supply to any patient registered in Wales via the Choose Pharmacy Platform. Details on how this service works can be found here:
